Hebrews 4:12

July 13th - *The Four Agreements:* Don't Take Anything Personally

August 3rd - Pushed by Pain, Pulled by Vision

August 10th - It Is Already Done: The Truth of Answered Affirmative Prayer

Is there any such thing as "unanswered prayer"? In Unity, we use affirmative prayer which is rooted in faith and the recognition of spiritual law. We do not beg or pray from a position of supplication but from a knowing and trusting the spiritual law behind prayer and belief that...

August 17th - "I Will": The CEO of My Life

Which part of your being is operating as Chief Executive Officer of your life? Let's explore this question and the part that our faculty of will plays in it.

August 24th - Now Is the Time

Unity emphasizes that the present moment is our point of power. It is only in the present moment that transformation takes place; but we must take the first step, we must persevere, and we must align ourselves with the flow of divine grace.

"Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation." II Corinthians 6:2

August 31st - Fifth Principle Sunday: Active Listening

In his book *The Fifth Agreement*, Don Miguel Ruiz suggests that we must "Be skeptical, but Learn to Listen." There is great power in doubt and in learning to be an active listener. "Is it truth. or is it not truth?"

Sept 7th - "What shall I do to inherit eternal life?"
